Adonai occurs 434 times in the Old Testament YHWH occurs 6519 times in the Old Testament

The Hebrews would read "Adonai" when they saw YHWH.

Elohim means "Supreme One" or "Mighty One"

Elohim or El is translated God in English

In English, we pronounce the personal name of God either Yahweh or Jehovah, but nobody knows for sure if this is correct. This is the name that means "I Am that I Am," or "I will be who I will be."

In the English Bible:

LORD (All capital Letters) is Yahweh or Jehovah.

Lord (Lower case letters) is Adonai.
