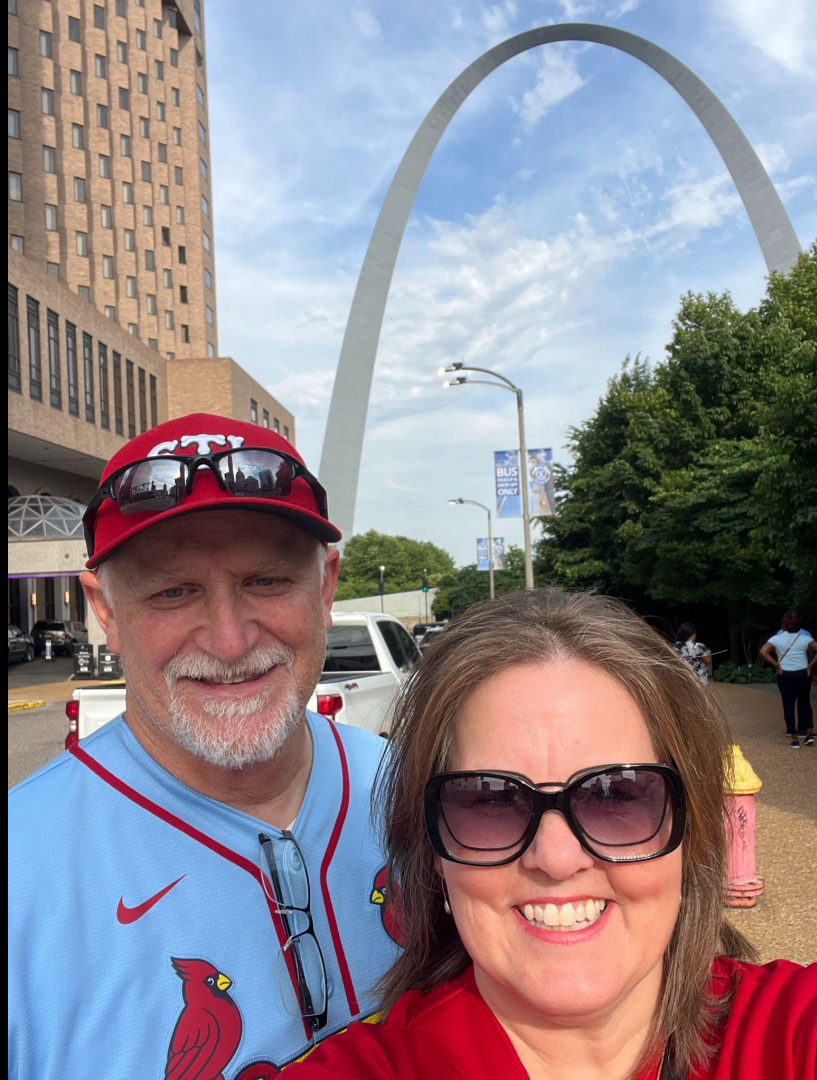

Euangelistēs - “Evangelist”

We are all evangelists when we believe that we have good news worth sharing, news that ignites passion.

1 Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God—

Apostle means “Sent One”

**“I must preach (*euangelizō*) the Kingdom of God, for I was sent (*apostellō*) for this reason.”
(Luke 4:43)**

“As the Father has sent me (*apostellō*), I am sending you.” (John 20:21)

We are all, like Paul, called and set apart as a “Sent one” for the sake of the “good news” of God.

² the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures ³ regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, ⁴ and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

⁵ Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith for his name's sake. ⁶ And you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.

⁷ To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be his holy people:

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 1

⁸ First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world. ⁹ God, whom I serve in my spirit in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how constantly I remember you ¹⁰ in my prayers at all times; and I pray that now at last by God's will the way may be opened for me to come to you.

Romans 1

¹¹ I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong— ¹² that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith. ¹³ I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that I planned many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles.

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

Romans 1

17 For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”

(1) Disciples of Jesus owe the gospel to the world.

(2) The gospel is God's power
for salvation

(3) The gospel reveals God's
righteousness

“... The righteousness of God is God’s righteous initiative in putting sinners right with himself, by bestowing on them a righteousness which is not their own but his. The righteousness of God is God’s just justification of the unjust, his righteous way of pronouncing the unrighteous righteous, in which he both demonstrates his righteousness and gives righteousness to us. He has done it through Christ, the righteous one, who died for the unrighteous...And he does it by faith when we put our trust in him, and cry to him for mercy.” (John Stott)

This world experiences God setting things right as believers in the gospel live our lives unashamed, by faith, with a passion to invite others into the joy of a relationship with Jesus.
