Big Question

Question - Why does sin separate us from God?

Answer - Because God is holy, sin has broken our relationship with God.

Bible Time

After God appeared to Moses at the burning bush, Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and said, "This is what the Lord says: Let My people go, so that they may worship Me."

Pharaoh replied, "Who is the Lord that I should obey him? I will not let Israel go." Pharaoh did not want the Israelites to stop the work they were doing as Egypt's slaves. To punish them for what Moses and Aaron had requested, Pharaoh made the Israelites work even harder.
