The most effective tool in Satan's belt is casting doubt about God's word. "Did God really say?" The answer is, "Yes!" Not only did God say it, but God also meant it.

QUESTIONS

- Those of us who have listened to this series since episode one have a working definition of the Holy Spirit the Triune God. Briefly, let's review.
- The Holy Spirit personally works in the hearts of believers. What does it mean to be a believer or a Christian?
- Briefly, what are some ways that the Holy Spirit ministers to Christians?

- Today's topic is about assurance – assurance that the believer's salvation is secure. How does the Holy Spirit “bear witness” that we are secure?
- A prominent word throughout the New Testament is “indwells.” In fact, this is the title of our series. How does this indwelling provide salvific assurance to the believer?
- Let's consider Romans 8:11 for a moment. How is our assurance linked to the resurrection of Jesus?
- Now, let's consider Romans 8:35-39. Can anything separate us from the love of God? Is this a promise? If so, will God change his mind if I sin or openly rebel against Him?
- What other way does the Holy Spirit communicate his love and security to the believer? How can believers fend off the doubt that attacks the mind?
- Any words of encouragement?
