## CONVERSATION GUIDE

The Trinity is an often-misunderstood characteristic of God, especially when it comes to the Third Person of the Godhead – the Holy Spirit. Some view the Holy Spirit as a third god. Others, a force instead of a person. In this series, we will discuss who He is, what His mission is, and why He can and should be worshipped.

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#### **TRUTH REVEALED**

Truth is under attack today. And those who scorn truth resort to ignoring it or insisting that it doesn't exist. True to God's character, the Holy Spirit leads us to all truth, and no amount of denial is going to change that.

#### **QUESTIONS**

- Let's review the territory we've covered thus far in this series – What is the Trinity? Who is the Holy Spirit?
- We've already covered some of His activities of the past, and how the Holy Spirit transforms our lives even through sanctification. Today we're covering how He reveals truth. Why is truth so important anyway? What problems do we see in our world that have resulted in denying truth?

- Many have no problem with religious people worshiping their gods, until that worship encroaches outside of church buildings. In other words, Christians need to keep their religion confined to the church building, and not bring with them. Why is this impossible for the believer?
- Does the so-called Christian truth really effect the rest of the world? In what ways? Why should non-Christians pay attention to what believers have to say?
- How does the Holy Spirit “lead” us to truth? If we have the Bible, why do we need the Holy Spirit?
- What other ways does the Holy Spirit lead us to truth?
- Some folks feel “led” by the Holy Spirit to make a proclamation or share a revelation in a public setting. How do we know if they have been led by the Holy Spirit? How do we know if what they said is truth? Is it uncharitable or disrespectful to question the Holy Spirit’s role in this revelation? Should we unquestionably believe religious leaders when they make these proclamations? Should we rely on our feelings to discern truth?
