

The Big Idea & Three *Shifts*

BIG IDEA

God is making ready a people. Revival does not come simply because of a great preacher or a great worship team — it comes when believers make themselves ready recipients of what the Spirit wants to do in this hour. Readiness always precedes outpouring.

THREE SHIFTS HAPPENING IN THE BODY OF CHRIST

1

A Return to Evangelism

We forgot how to win souls. A lost and dying generation is waiting — and someone has to go get them.

2

A Season of Equipping

Getting people saved is not enough. They must be equipped to walk in the purpose God created them for, or they will not last.

3

A Fresh Empowerment

A hunger for the true power of God and the gifts of the Spirit — not a watered-down, casual, comfortable faith.

WHAT "READY" MEANS

To make ready means to make the necessary preparations and get everything in order. God is calling out a people — a tribe, a family of shared faith — and preparing them, equipping them, and furnishing them for the work of the ministry.

Five Key Scriptures

Luke 1:17

the spirit of elijah

The forerunner comes in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children — to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Readiness is preparation on purpose.

Acts 3:1–10

what i have, i give

Peter and John meet the lame man at the Beautiful Gate. "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you." Readiness releases what has already been deposited in you.

Luke 22:31–34

sifted as wheat

Satan asks to sift Simon as wheat, but Jesus prays that his faith would not fail. Readiness is often forged through a refining season, not a comfortable one.

Romans 1:11–12

a sharing house

Paul longs to impart a spiritual gift so the church may be established, "that we may be mutually encouraged." Readiness is a shared work — every gift matters, not just those on a platform.

Matthew 4:19–20

leave the nets

"Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." They immediately left their nets. Being made ready often requires walking away from what we hold dear.
