### Key Points

We must read the Bible regularly in order to know what it says.

**Start Talking.** Find a conversation starter for your group.

**Start Thinking.** Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What are the means by which God makes us wise for salvation and equips us for every good work?
- Why should we believe the Bible is authoritative?
- If the Scriptures are the means by which God preserves our faith and conforms us to the likeness of Christ, then they are absolutely essential for our eternal well-being. Why, then, would we ever neglect the study of Scripture?

**Start Sharing.** Choose a question to create openness.

- What challenges prevent you from reading the Bible every day?
- What does your response to this say about who you are?
- Are there any excuses you make that may be holding you back?

**Start Praying.** Be bold and pray with power.

Lord, as I open the pages of the living word, I open the pages of my heart and life to you. As I drink in the words of your love and grace, may I pour out that unending mercy and hope into all that I do. Amen.

**Start Doing.** Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- What specific actions do you need to take to diligently seek God in ready and studying the Bible?
