Stand Alone The Glory of God



Talking through the message during the week helps you turn what God is saying to you into action steps. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take the next step.

Key Scripture

"Whether therefore ye eat or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31

"My glory I will not give to another." God will give temporal blessings to his children, such as wisdom, **Isaiah. 48:11**

Psalm 29:2. "Give unto the Lord the glory due unto his name; worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness."

GLORIFYING GOD CONSISTS OF FOUR THINGS:

- 1. Appreciation.
- 2. Adoration, or worship
- 3. Affection
- 4. Subjection

Big idea: "Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him forever." — **The Westminster Shorter Catechism**

Worship Charades:

Write down the titles of different worship songs. Divide your city group into two teams and play a game of "Worship Charades." Afterwards, the winning team then gets to choose the chorus of any song for the losing team to sing together. You decide whether or not to Instagram that one!

Key Questions:

- When you hear the word 'glory' what do you think of? Why?
- How would you define "The Glory of God?".
- What makes up the glory of God? Describe characteristics of God's glory.
 How is God's glory pictured in the Bible? Why do you think God uses these pictures to represent His glory?

Additional Questions:

- How has God revealed his Glory most comprehensively? (John 1:1- 14 and Hebrews 1:1-4)
- What is the connection between "Glory" and "Goodness"?
- Think of a discouraging time in your life. How would catching a glimpse of God's Glory have impacted you during this time?

Next Steps: What is one practical thing you can do this week to live for the glory of God in Jesus' way and not in the world's way? Write it down and reflect on it through the week. Or, if you are in a city group, discuss this with one another.
