



Talking through the weekly message helps you turn information into application. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you make the next move. If you're leading a movement city group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

City Group Icebreaker: Questions to Get You Talking

- When has the Lord delivered you from a serious sickness or difficulty in your life? How did you react? Did you keep it secret or did you tell others?
- What makes you resistant to talking about God?

Key Scriptures: 19 And He did not let him, but He said to him, “Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He had mercy on you.” 20 And he went away and began to proclaim in Decapolis what great things Jesus had done for him; and everyone was amazed. **Mark 5:19-20**

Big Idea of the Message:

Message Study:

- How did God speak to you in the message?
- Was there anything you didn't understand?
- What did the man who had been possessed of the demon want to do, but what did Jesus tell him to do instead 5:19,20?
- Why does Jesus not allow this man to “be with him?” After all, isn't this a good desire the man has?
- Why is this man told to “go and tell” rather than to remain silent?

Start Thinking.

- Often Jesus asked those that he healed to be quiet about the healing, but he told this man to tell others about it (5:19). Why? When Jesus touched your life (assuming he did), do you think he would ask you to be quiet about it or tell others about it?
- OIKOS/MOVE OUT MAPPING – Oikos is the Greek word for household. One of the ways the gospel spreads so rapidly is through relational networks. This appears to be an intentional and strategic method used by both Jesus and the Paul. Pastor Dre discusses how Jesus' model of discipleship is based on physical presence among disciples. Paul's model is leading from distance, but are they really so different (Read John 16:7)?

Start Sharing.

- When Jesus found people who were open to His message, He would eventually share the message with others in their relational network (Friends, Neighbor, Relative, Work, School, Other). Who are the people in your network that you should share the gospel with (Friends, Neighbor, Relative, Work, School, Other)?
- We are said to be Christ's ambassadors, not just when we are out in a foreign mission field, but in our everyday life. Can you be an ambassador for Christ without being on mission? Who in your relational network can you identify, intercede for, invest in and invite to your MTG's or MCG's?

Start Praying. I am thankful that God is helping us add to the church daily such as should be saved. We believe that we exist for those not here yet. We will be obedient to the plan of God for our lives and allow the Holy Spirit to direct our footsteps to those who are in our relational network. According to the Word of God, His Word will increase and the number of disciples will be multiplied. As I am a co-laborer with God, we confess His glory is manifested in us daily.


Only three tasks are to be accomplished in a (MTG):
