KINGDOM CULTURE: FOR THE GOOD OF THE CITY

Text: Matthew 28:19-20

Topic: Kingdom, Discipleship,

Big Idea of the Message: Why is it hard to make disciples? Said another way, why is it hard to promote growth?

Read Matthew 28:19-20: Take the time to commit the following story from scripture to memory. Use your own words. Expressing the lessons of the passage is as important as the details. Use it to teach the following lessons.

Tell the message: Short term Discipleship.

Retell the message: Together from this week's webisode.

Self Discovery: Teaching obedience to such commands of Jesus is not a one time event, rather it requires ongoing practice motivated by their love relationship with God (John 14:15/14:21/15:10)

We see the first church fulfilling at least seven of the clear commands of Christ in this passage. They are:

- 1) Repentance and Faith – v. 38
- 2) Baptism – v. 39
- 3) Love (service, fellowship and worship)
- 4) Observance of the Lord's Supper – v. 42,46
- 5) Giving – v.45
- 6) Prayer – v.42
- 7) Great Commission – v.38, 47

Take time to examine "The Seven Commands of Christ" in relation to your own obedience.

GOALS TO SET:

- **Obey:** Confess your sins before the Lord. Turn from them and live a new life in Jesus.
- **Abide:** Begin reading Matthew 28:19-20 in its entirety and pray daily.
- **Train:** You need to train your disciples in this.
- **Share:** If you don't have a disciple, who from your Oikos map will you share the webisode with this week?"
