Talking through the weekly message helps you turn information into application. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you make the next move.

City Group Icebreaker: Questions to Get You Talking

Have you ever been awakened from a sound sleep? What was it like and how did it make you feel?

**Key Scriptures:** <sup>11</sup> And do this, understanding the present time. The hour has come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. <sup>12</sup> The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. <sup>13</sup> Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy. <sup>14</sup> Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature. **Romans 13:11–14** 

MTG Scriptures: Read Romans 13 in its entirety.

Big Idea of the Message: Our time of waiting is not wasted but is an important part of God's plan.

Message Study: The Essential Questions

- · What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
- Have you ever thought about Advent as a time of anticipating not just the incarnation, but the second coming of Christ? How
  does that change this season?
- Why do you think light is such a significant image in the Bible?
- What are some ways that God uses our waiting, instead of wasting it?
- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?

Move Up. Connect to Christ

Are you waiting expectantly for Christ? What does that look like and how does that impact your love for God?

Start Praying. Lord, deepen my love of You. Help me to love you more than all things.

Move Out. Connect to Culture.

• These are Paul's instructions for us in our current time of waiting: "put on the armor of light" (v. 12), "behave decently" (v. 13), and "clothe" ourselves with Jesus (v. 14). How does these instructions influence how you love others?

**Start Praying.** Lord Jesus, I want to join You in better loving my neighbors. Teach me, to see others as you would see them. I ask also for your forgiveness. I have failed to show grace to our neighbor. Help me to refine these gifts you have given us, love others as self.

Move In. Connect Culture to Christ.

What does it look like for us to partner with God in his redemptive project on earth right here and now, in our time of waiting?

**Start Praying.** Lord Jesus, I want to join You in your mission. Send me, as an ambassador to share Your good news with \_\_\_\_\_. Help me use truth as a light to guide me, and grace as a hand to hold the weary. Help me to be your disciple.

Application Point: Our time of waiting should prompt us to partner with God in his redemption of this world.
