



Talking through the weekly message helps you turn information into application. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you make the next move. If you're leading a movement city group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

City Group Icebreaker: *Questions to Get You Talking*

- Do you think it is possible to truly be a Christian if one does not share the Gospel, suffer for the Gospel, or live in the character of Christ as He Himself ministered the Gospel?
- What might this say about those who define Christianity in terms other than those used by Christ in this teaching?

Key Scriptures: *Matthew 10:1-11, Mark 6:7-13, Luke 10:1-11*

Big Idea of the Message: A person of peace is someone God has prepared and placed in your path who is ready to hear the message you are bringing about the Kingdom of God and the King.

Message Study:

- Who is sending you? Where is he sending you?
- What are you supposed to do?
- Who does Jesus expect you to find when you do this?
- What is a person of peace like? What are you supposed to do once you find them?
- What message are you to share?

Start Thinking.

- How did God speak to you in the message? Was there anything you didn't understand?
- We learn by doing. We need to get out and share the gospel rather than just read more books about how to do it. What can you learn from the phrase "sent out?" How is this an integral part of the mission of the church?
- Are there any persons of peace in your own life?

Start Sharing.

- Read Luke 10:1-4 and John 4:35-38. Talk about the importance of sharing the gospel. What are the dangers? What are the rewards?
- What are some reasons that we delay or avoid sharing the gospel? Pray that you might have opportunities this week to share the good news with someone.
- Is God saying anything? What will you do about it?

Start Praying. I am thankful that God is helping us add to the church daily such as should be saved. We believe that we exist for those not here yet. We will be obedient to the plan of God for our lives and allow the Holy Spirit to direct our footsteps to those who are in our relational network. According to the Word of God, His Word will increase and the number of disciples will be multiplied. As I am a co-laborer with God, we confess His glory is manifested in us daily.

Connect To Culture

We are not only called to pray about the harvest but called into the harvest to serve. At some point we will have to personally put our faith into practice. Make a list of three people who might be persons of peace. Pray for them for one week. Invite each one of them to coffee/lunch and during the conversation, let them know you are a person of prayer and ask how you can pray for them. See what happens next. Remember to do this with integrity. That means follow through and pray for that person for another week. Then follow up to see how the prayers were answered. Evaluate the relationship based on what you learn from this teaching.

Movement News

- No matter where you come from, there's a group for you. Join or start an MTG and experience how the gospel can transform your life. A MTG is made up of two or three people, all of the same gender, who meet weekly for personal accountability for their spiritual growth and development. There are only two suggested qualification for starting or joining a MTG:
 1. A desperate need for Jesus (Luke 5:29-32).
 2. Faithfulness in the process itself (2 Tim. 2:2).

Movement Transformation Groups (MTG's) are a simple way to release the most essential elements of a vital spiritual walk to people who need Jesus to change their lives from the inside out. We want to see people experience life change, support one another through the challenges of life, as well as pray and care for one another. (MTG's) empower the common Christian to accomplish the uncommon work of reproducing spiritual disciples who can in turn reproduce others.

Only three tasks are to be accomplished in a (MTG):

- Sin is confessed in mutual accountability.
- Scripture is read repetitively in context and in community.
- Souls are prayed for strategically, specifically, and continuously

MTG Weekly Emphasis:

- This week you are to read Mark 6 in it's entirety in context and in community.

These questions at the least are to be asked of one another on a weekly meeting of accountability (Proverbs 27:17). They are to stimulate conversations of character and confession of sin in a safe environment, which values, honesty, vulnerability, confidentiality, and grace.

1. Have you been a testimony this week to the greatness of Jesus Christ with both your words and actions?
2. Do I have 2-3 people outside and inside of my family that I am helping to grow spiritually?
3. What have you done lately to "build a bridge" for the purpose of sharing the gospel?
