KINGDOM CULTURE: FOR THE GOOD OF THE CITY

Text: Mark 4:26-29

Topic: Kingdom, Discipleship

Big Idea of the Message: The life you want is never the result of a few lucky decisions. It's always the result of countless consistent, seemingly small decisions over time.

Read Mark 4:26-29. Think about what you're sowing in life right now. What do you think you'll reap?

Tell the message: How Does The Kingdom Grow.

Retell the message together from this week's webisode.

Read the message aloud from this week's scripture.

Discover: Sowers is the beginning of God's plan. God has chosen to use his people as the catalysts of his kingdom. The scripture repeatedly speaks of our duty and the awesome privilege of representing the creator and his redemptive plan. As we consider the need for sowers, the church planter is well served to consider the following questions concerning his own expectations of sowers. The answers to these simple questions have a huge impact on the potential of his or her ministry.

Important questions concerning sowers:

- 1) What does a sower do?
- 2) Who is qualified to be a sower?

Pray, then use the following Bible Study method to discuss the message and reveal its meaning for our lives.

- What do we learn from the message about TMH (Father, Jesus, Holy Spirit)?
- What do we learn from the people in the message?
- Is there anything from the message TMH God wants us to obey?

Practice Retelling the message

GOALS TO SET:

- **Obey:** Confess your sins before the Lord. Turn from them and live a new life in Jesus.
- **Abide:** Begin reading Mark 4:26-34 in its entirety and pray daily.
- **Train:** You need to train your disciples in this.
- **Share:** If you don't have a disciple, who from your Oikos map will you share the webisode with this week?"
