Ridiculous Commitment

Talking through the message during the week helps you turn what God is saying to you into action steps. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take the next step.

Key Scripture

19 So he departed from there and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, while he was plowing with twelve pairs of oxen before him, and he with the twelfth. And Elijah passed over to him and threw his mantle on him. 20 He left the oxen and ran after Elijah and said, “Please let me kiss my father and my mother, then I will follow you.” And he said to him, “Go back again, for what have I done to you?” 21 So he returned from following him, and took the pair of oxen and sacrificed them and boiled their flesh with the implements of the oxen, and gave it to the people and they ate. Then he arose and followed Elijah and ministered to him. 1 Kings 19:19-21

Key Points

- 1) YOU DON'T HAVE TO UNDERSTAND FULLY TO OBEY IMMEDIATELY.
- 2) THOSE GOD USES THE MOST ARE THE ONES WHO HOLD ON TO THE LEAST.

Big Idea: To step toward your destiny, you must step away from your security.

TALK IT OVER

Start Talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- With your Bible or Movement App read and discuss 1 Kings 19:19-21
- What examples of ridiculous commitment to God have you witnessed in your life?

Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Describe a time when you obeyed God even though you didn't fully understand His direction. What resulted from your obedience?
- What is God asking you to do that you need to obey immediately?

Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Pastor Dre said, “Those God uses the most are the ones who hold on to the least.” Have you experienced this in your own life? If so, how?
- How would you describe your level of trust in God? What might be keeping you from fully trusting in Him?

Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- What's one step of obedience you can take this week to respond to what God is asking you to do?
- What security do you need to step away from that will allow you to step toward your destiny?

Dinner Discussion. Step toward your destiny with ridiculous commitment to God by reading and talking over the following Bible passages this week.
