Bible Reading:

1. Exodus 3:14: "God said to Moses, 'I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.'"

2. John 14:6: "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"

3. John 6:35: "Then Jesus declared, 'I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty."

4. John 6:47-51: "Very truly I tell you, the one who believes has eternal life. I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness, yet they died. But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which anyone may eat and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

Observation Questions:

 What are the similarities and differences between God's declaration to Moses in Exodus 3:14 and Jesus' statements in John 14:6 and John 6:35?
 In John 6:47-51, what does Jesus mean when he says he is the "bread of life" and the "living bread that came down from heaven"?

Interpretation Questions:

How does Jesus' statement in John 14:6 about being the way, the truth, and the life relate to the concept of him being the "bread of life" as stated in John 6:35?
 In the context of Exodus 3:14 and John 6:47-51, how can we understand the concept of Jesus offering eternal life?

Application Questions:

1. Reflecting on Jesus' statement in John 6:35, how can you actively seek to be filled by Jesus, the bread of life, in your daily life?

2. Considering Jesus' declaration in John 14:6, what is one specific way you can demonstrate your belief in Jesus as the way, the truth, and the life to someone you interact with regularly?

3. In light of Exodus 3:14 and Jesus' "I Am" statements, how can you incorporate the understanding of God's eternal existence into your prayer life this week?
4. Reflecting on John 6:47-51, how can you share the message of Jesus being the living bread that offers eternal life with someone who is spiritually hungry?
5. How can you hand over control of a specific area of your life to Jesus, trusting in his guidance and eternal existence?
