Background & Review

A setting that looks back to Moses' calling (Exodus 18:5; 3:1, 12)

The Reunion of Moses and Jethro

Verses 1-4: God as the author of history and salvation (Proverbs 16:9, 33; Acts 17:26-28; Acts 4:27-28)

Verses 5-12: God's glory in history and salvation among all the nations (Exodus 17:8; 18:5; 15:22-17:7; Romans 2:17-24; 1 Corinthians 1:26)

Application: The Saving and Enabling Grace of God

The saving grace of God should enable us to:

- 1. Rejoice in God's goodness to others.
- 2. Show honor and affection toward others.
- 3. Not be defined by or stuck in the mire of our troubles.
- 4. Praise God personally
- 5. Praise God with others
