

Structure of Romans 15:14-33

- Paul describes his ministry to the unreached (14-21)
- Paul reveals his mission plans and need for support (22-29)
- Paul asks for prayer for his mission and concludes with a blessing (30-33)

The Goal of the Passage: Reveal the shape and character of Gospel Ministry

Main Points:

1. Gospel ministry recognizes the supreme worth of God (16, 18; 12:1-2)
2. Gospel ministry boasts in Christ (17, 18, 19, 21; Isaiah 52:15)
3. Gospel ministry shows love for the local church (23-27, 32)
4. Gospel ministry has ambition for others to hear the good news (20-22, 24, 28, 29; Matthew 28:18-20)
5. Gospel ministry makes an effort to pray together (30-33)
6. Gospel ministry keeps the mindset that we are all ministers (14, 16, 26, 30; Romans 12:1-2)
