1. Go!!! Matthew 28:16-20

Vs 16 Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had **told** them to go.

They obeyed what **He** asked them to do.

Vs 17

“When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted.”

HIS goal is that all HIS Disciples we move from doubt to faith.

Philippians 1: 6 – “being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.”

Vs 18 His response:

¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

They needed to be reminded of His AUTHORITY:

Authority in His teaching:

The people were astonished at His teaching, because He taught as one who had authority, and not as the scribes.

Mark 1:22

He taught the people in their synagogue, and they were astonished. “Where did this man get such wisdom and miraculous powers?” they asked.

Matthew 13:54

AUTHORITY In His healing:

Countless times the Disciples saw Him heal the **lame**,
the **blind** and the **sick** with **all the authority of heaven!**

His AUTHORITY to forgive sin:

“But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on the earth to forgive sins...” He said to the paralytic, “I tell you, get up, pick up your mat, and go home.”

Luke 5:24

His AUTHORITY over Satan:

Then Jesus called the Twelve together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and power to cure diseases. And He sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Luke

9:1-2

Vs 19

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,”

“NOW GO!!!” - Present participle means: As you are going... While you are living out your life...



Vs 20

“and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

HE Commanded them to Pray

“So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ¹⁰ For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

HE Commanded them to Abide in God's Word

Jesus says, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free”

HE Commanded them to Love one another

Acts 1: 3-11

3 After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God. 4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but **wait** for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

6 Then they gathered around him and asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”

7 He said to them: “It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own **authority**.⁸

⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

⁹ After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

¹⁰ They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. ¹¹ “Men of Galilee,” they said, “why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven.”
