

Sermon Text: Exodus 15:22-17:7

In Pro-Presenter Stack these large passages as three separate ones:

- 15:22-27
- 16:1-36
- 17:1-7

Main Idea: The Lord provides for His people in every trial.

Three Lessons on the Lord's Provision

1. The LORD provides in ways we don't expect (15:25; 16:4; 17:6 1 Corinthians 10:4; John 6:32-35)

Implication: Our grumbling reveals a lack of faith in the God who continually amazes his people in the way He provides.

2. The LORD provides through a faithful mediator (15:25; 16:12; 17:4; Deuteronomy 18:15; Acts 3:22)

Implication: Grumbling reveals a hostility toward God and his chosen means of providing for you.

3. The LORD provides because of His great mercy (15:24, 27; 16:20, 28, 35; 17:6; 1 Corinthians 10:4; Romans 5:20).

Implication: Grumbling reveals forgetfulness

Applications:

1. Pay attention to yourself (1 Corinthians 10:11-12)

2. Receive God's rest in the Gospel of Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 10:6; Exodus 16:27-30)
