Sermon Title: God is the Strong One: How Then Should We Worship?

Main Question: How should God's saving strength shape our worship?

Because God saves with supreme strength:

1. We worship to remember His saving strength (1-3, 6, 7, 12, 13, 15; Psalm 73; 2 Corinthians 5:21)

2. We worship with our children (7-9, 14; Joshua 8:34-35)

3. We worship in faith (19, 1-2, 11-16; Numbers 3:1-4:49; Hebrews 11:22)

4. We worship in hope (17-18, 21-22; John 1; Hebrews 12:18-24)
