Romans 14:13-23

The main point of these verses is essentially right in the center of the text: Verse 19: "So then, let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding."

Main Point: As brothers and sisters in the family of God we must pursue edifying peace with one another.

The context and background: One People, made up of two very different backgrounds (vv. 1-12)

Logic and Structure of the Text:

Verse 13 - You need to care about whether or not your brother stumbles

Verses 14-16, You need to ask yourself, "is the use of my freedom helping or hindering my brother's faith? Is the use of my freedom helping or hindering my faith?

Verses 17-18, The most important thing.

Verses 19-20a, The crux of the matter: Peace that edifies

Verses 20b-23, The footnotes

Four things that Christians will do to pursue edifying peace 1. Obey your own conscience

- 2. Honor your brother's conscience
- 3. Ask the Lord to shape your conscience as you study God's word
- 4. Focus on serving Jesus
