- 2) Why does Jesus make a distinction between “shepherds” and “hired hands”? In life, how do you tell the difference between “hired hands” and The Good Shepherd?
- 3) When in your life have you memorably experienced the protection of The Good Shepherd? How does this memory shape your response when “wolves” threaten your security?

**Psalm 23:**

- 1) How can Jesus be “The Good Shepherd” in your life and relationships? What part of this Psalm speaks most convincingly to your need for Jesus to guide you in to your truest identity found in Him?
