**Today's Focus:** Our hopes for 2020, and 100 years from now as a church.

### What We Covered:

**Vision:** That ASC would be “a movement of people joining God’s transformation of all things” (Rev 21:1-5)

**Rev 21:** 1 Then I saw “a new heaven and a new earth,”[a] for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. 2 I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Look! God’s dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 4 ‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’[b] or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.” 5 He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!” Then he said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.”

**Mission:** That we would “make disciples by living Jesus’ way, truth, and life together.” (Matthew 28:18-20 | John 14:6)

**Matthew 28:** 18 Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

**John 14:** 6 Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

### Goals for our Church in 2020:

1. Build & sustain a strong core group of volunteers and leaders
2. Grow an active and committed congregation
3. Establish an infrastructure for ASC to be a healthy, growing church.

### THIS WEEK’S REFLECTION FOR YOU & YOUR ASC SMALL GROUP

4. **(John 14:6):** As a church, we believe disciples are made by living Jesus’ way, truth, and life together. What is one way you can do so this week? Today?
