1. An $\qquad$
a. "These are the words of him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open. I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut." Revelation 3:7-8
b. The letter of the church at Philadelphia represents an exciting era in church history from about 1750 to 1900 . This was an era of great revivals, and an era when the modern missionary movement began. It also was an era of amazing growth in the church, with evangelical Christians composing fully $30-40 \%$ of the population of the U.S.
c. Jesus has promised to give his followers an open door. He will give us favor wherever the gospel is proclaimed.
2. Victory Over $\qquad$ (Opposition)!
a. "I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. I will make those who are of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not, but are liars - I will make them come and fall down at your feet and acknowledge that I have loved you." Revelation 3:8-9
b. How does Satan let the air out of your balloon? How does he discourage you? Whatever it is you are struggling with today, don't ever forget God has giving you the victory over that. Trust him day by day. We will always give you the next step to take.
3. Protection From the $\qquad$ (Great Tribulation)!
a. "Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth." Revelation 3:10
b. The Greek preposition "ek" meaning "out of " is used in vs. 10 (translated "from" in the NIV). The preposition "dia" meaning "through" could have been used to communicate that we would be kept "through" the hour of trial. God's people will be raptured before the seven-year period of tribulation begins.
c. "Wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead - Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath." I Thessalonians 1:10 "For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ." I Thessalonians 5:9
4. Eternal $\qquad$ (Reward) - Present and Future!
a. "I am coming soon. Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take your crown. Him who overcomes I will make a pillar in the temple of my God." Revelation 3:11-12
b. Eternal life and eternal reward start the moment you receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord. And it never ends!
c. The name of God, the name of God's city, the new Jerusalem, and the name of Jesus will all be written on us. The new Jerusalem will be our eternal home in a way that this earth never was.
