

Survival

Denial

In this stage the person says that there is no issue.

Praying /Asking God


In this stage the

Believe God


In this stage the

Turn from their sin


In this stage the person realizes their sin and asks God for forgiveness.

Sin No More and Live Differently


In this stage the

- Realize that you cannot return to that sin.
 - Turn away from the sin and turn toward God.
 - Live your life differently knowing that God has transformed you.



God Will Heal

In this stage the
person turns away
from sin and follows
God's leading.

- 
- God is capable of healing.
 - God promises that if you humble yourself and seek your face that He will heal.
 - God does what He says He will do.
 - God tells us that our faith has healed us.
