

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Q:** Why are we moving?

A: Changes in our surroundings, such as the closure of Conley Elementary School and the influx of industrial buildings, signaled a shifting environment that could threaten the church's sustainability and growth. With God's grace, we will expand the vision to Gather, Grow and Go.

2. **Q:** Which area do you plan to move to?

A: Although the specific location is unknown at this time, we are considering locations near 249, Hwy 99, and the north side of 1960.

3. **Q:** What is the projected timeframe for our new location?

A: We are currently in the process of evaluating potential sites that not only meet our immediate needs but also align with our long-term goals for sustainability, viability, and growth.

4. **Q:** When is our last day at 4170 West Green Road, our current location?

A: New Destiny's last day at 4170 West Greens Rd. will be July 13, 2024.

5. **Q:** Will Bishop Ogletree still be the pastor?

A: Yes, Bishop Ogletree will still be the pastor at New Destiny.

6. **Q:** Will we still have Bible study on Wednesday nights?

A: Bible study will continue to be on Wednesday nights at 7pm at 4170 West Greens Road until June 27, 2024. After this date, Wednesday night bible study will be via zoom at 7pm.

7. **Q:** Will we continue to meet at our normal Sunday service times?

A: From June 23-July 7, 2024, we will continue to have both 8am and 10 am services. Starting July 14, 2024, we will have one Sunday service.

A: The church name will remain the same.

13. **Q:** How will ND members be notified of updates?

14. **Q:** Are we still going to have VBS?

A: Yes, VBS will continue as planned.

15. **Q:** If we move into a storefront, will it be temporary?

A: Yes, if we transition into a storefront location it will only be temporary.

16. **Q:** Will there be a capacity limit on the store front and if so, do we register to attend?

A: At this time, we do not foresee a registration needed.

17. **Q:** Will we still have 2 services going forward?

A: No, starting July 14, 2024, we will only have 1 service...10 am service.

18. **Q:** How will the move impact food distribution? Will there be one last distribution in July?

A: We will have our final food distribution on Saturday, July 13th.

19. **Q:** Are there things in general that we can do?

A: You can stop by the church at any time to help box items. You will need to sign in with Mrs. Marsha.

20. **Q:** What is the earliest time that I may arrive to help with the move?

A: The church office opens at 9am and closes at 5pm. Extended hours will be available for those who would like to assist after hours.

21. **Q:** Why did we decide to sell the church?

A: The decision to sell the church was made after extensive deliberation and prayer.

22. **Q:** How was the decision made?

A: The decision was made through a comprehensive process involving the church leadership, and the infrastructure team. Surveys and consultations were conducted before reaching a consensus.

23. **Q:** What will happen to the current building?

A: The current building has been sold to a buyer. The proceeds from the sale will be used to finance our transition into the new building.

24. **Q:** How will this transition affect our regular services and activities?

A: During the transition we will have 8am and 10am service on June 23, we will have Unity service on June 30 10am. First Sunday July 7 we will have an 8am and 10am service.

25. **Q:** How can congregation members help during this transition?

A: Members can help by participating in volunteer opportunities during the move and continuing to pray for a smooth transition. We will provide specific details on how you can get involved as the move date approaches

26. **Q:** What if some members have concerns about the move?

A: We understand that change can be challenging, and we are here to listen to any concerns. Members are encouraged to speak with church leaders or attend our scheduled meetings to discuss any issues or questions they might have.

27. **Q:** How will we commemorate the history and memories of our current building?

A: We will hold a special service to honor the history and memories of our current building.
