How Does God Build My Faith?

PHASE 1: Dream

“God is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of – infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes.” ~ Ephesians 3:20 (TLB)

Nothing happens in your life until you start dreaming.

How to Know If a Dream is from God:

1. God’s dream will always require faith.

If a dream comes from God, it’s going to be so big, you can’t do it on your own. You can only do it by faith.

2. God’s dream will never contradict God’s word.

PHASE 2: Decision

“You must believe and not doubt.. a double-minded man is unstable in all he does.” ~ James 1:6,8 (GNT)

Nothing is going to happen to your dream until you wake up and put it into action.

The Decision Phase:

1. You must invest.
2. You must let go of security.

PHASE 3: Delay

“These things I plan won’t happen right away. Slowly, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled.” ~ Habakkuk 2:3 (TLB)

PHASE 4: Difficulty

“At present you may be temporarily harassed by all kinds of trials. This is not accident-it happens to prove your faith, which is infinitely more valuable than gold.” ~ 1 Peter 1:6-7

PHASE 5: Dead End

“At that time, we were completely overwhelmed, the burden was more than we could bear, in fact we told ourselves that this was the end. Yet we now believe that we had this sense of impending disaster so that we might learn to trust, not in ourselves, but in God who can raise the dead!” ~ 2 Corinthians 1:8-9

PHASE 6: Deliverances

“He has delivered...and he will deliver us again!” ~ 2 Corinthians 1:10

2. God’s dream for you is positive.

How to Discover God’s Dream for You

Dedicate My Life to God

“Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to his service Do not conform yourselves to the standards of his world, but let God transform you Then you will be able to know the will of God-what is good and is pleasing to him and is perfect.” ~ Romans 12:1-2 (GNT)

Reserve Time Alone with God

Make My Dream Public

Visualize the dream-and then verbalize the dream.

1. It gets you started.
2. It attracts other people.
3. It releases God's power.
