

## You are Never Alone

### LESSON 2 – GOD IS WITH YOU WHEN YOU'RE STUCK

#### Part 2

*"As he traveled through Galilee, he came to Cana, where he had turned the water into wine. There was a government official in nearby Capernaum whose son was very sick.<sup>47</sup> When he heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, he went and begged Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal his son, who was about to die.<sup>48</sup> Jesus asked, "Will you never believe in me unless you see miraculous signs and wonders?"<sup>49</sup> The official pleaded, "Lord, please come now before my little boy dies."<sup>50</sup> Then Jesus told him, "Go back home. Your son will live!" And the man believed what Jesus said and started home.<sup>51</sup> While the man was on his way, some of his servants met him with the news that his son was alive and well.<sup>52</sup> He asked them when the boy had begun to get better, and they replied, "Yesterday afternoon at one o'clock his fever suddenly disappeared!"*" **John 4:46-52 (NLT)**

The Bible is full of stories of people who waited on the Lord for a miracle. Abraham and Sarah waited for a son (Genesis 21). Joseph waited to be let go out of prison (Genesis 41). The Israelites waited to enter into the Promised Land (Joshua 3). Elizabeth waited on a child (Luke 1). There must be a purpose for all of this waiting in Scripture!

#### Jesus Heals an Official's Son

1. Jesus was instructing the Official to take him at his **word** and **trust** that the prayer offered in Cana would be answered in Capernaum.
2. Jesus was asking him to **believe**.

*"Then the father realized that that was the very time Jesus had told him, "Your son will live." And he and his entire household believed in Jesus."* **John 4:53 (NLT)**

3. Jesus' miracle was not just in **giving life** to the boy.
4. The life-giving healing of the boy was a **temporary** gift.
5. The faith-giving miracle to the family was **eternal**.

The God of the Bible is a God of forward motion. He is ready to write a new chapter in your biography. But he will demand that you take action to *live out* that new chapter.
