LESSON 5 – MUDDY WATER

*"For God so **loved** the world that he **gave** his one and only Son, that whoever **believes in** him shall not perish but **have** eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him." John 3:16-17 (NIV)*

One of the biggest challenges of sharing Jesus with a non-believer is navigating through the complexities of Christian theology. In fact, maybe you've shied away from fishing because you weren't confident of your ability to explain all the elements of the doctrine of salvation. Even if you understand that man is born into sin and why bad things happen to good people, and how God predestined certain events... that doesn't mean you can explain it all to somebody who's never heard it.

2. Few Christians are skilled at making a **simple** presentation of the gospel. Often, we overcomplicate it.
