LESSON 6 – POURED OUT FOR BLESSING

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." John 15:5-8 (NIV)

When we remain in Jesus and He remains in us through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, we bear much fruit. When we abide in Christ and nourish our faith with His words—God's truth, we grow more mature and produce divine fruit—love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. When we live in our anointing and obey God into the next season of our anointing, our fruit ripens.

THE SAME SPIRIT

1. The new wine of the Spirit not only resides in you, it overflows and **pours** out blessing, healing, and praise in all areas of our life.

"Yes indeed, it won't be long now....Things are going to happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won't be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings! Blessings like wine pouring off the mountains and hills." Amos 9:13-15 (MSG)

2. As the power of the Spirit produces **fruit** in your life, you can no longer remain silent.

3. When the Spirit fills your heart, your life naturally **releases** the sounds of praise, blessing, and healing.
4. Being filled by the Holy Spirit always begins with a **sound**.

From Genesis to Revelation and throughout the pages of the Bible, the greatest shifts began with a sound. With a sound, the architect of the universe pushed back darkness when He said, *"Let there be light."* **Genesis 1:3 (NIV)**

Guess who is coming back with a loud sound? **Jesus**. *"For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first."* **1 Thessalonians 4:16 (NIV)**

5. Spiritually speaking, your sounds release the fruit of what God's Spirit is **doing** in you.

"Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me." **John 15:4 (NKJV)**

6. As you grow and mature in the Spirit, as the fruit of the Spirit ripens in your life, it's time to make some noise.

TRUTH OF THE SPIRIT

1. When you experience the power of the Holy Spirit within you, you bear spiritual fruit.

*“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness and self-control.” **Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV)***

2. These same spiritual fruit attributes reflect who God is, and since we are created in His image by Him and empowered by His Spirit within us, it makes sense that these attributes grow in us.
3. How do we produce the fruit of the Spirit? By abiding in Christ!

*“Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? ¹²Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? ¹³If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!” **Luke 11:11-13 (NIV)***
