Big Idea: Gift of Prayer

Memory Verse: “Each of you has received a gift in order to serve others. You should use it faithfully.”

1 Peter 4:10 (NIRV)

Guided Story Time – Jesus Prays (John 17)

Recap what we learned today with your kids.

- What festival were they celebrating? *Passover*
- Where were Jesus and his disciples going? *Jerusalem*
- What did Jesus do while he was with his disciples? *He looked up to God and prayed*
- Who did Jesus pray for? *He prayed for his disciples and everyone who would come to know God*

Big Idea Application – Gift of Prayer

These questions are designed to help kids apply the lesson to their own lives. Ask these questions to help start the conversation!

- Why is it important to pray?
- How can you use the gift of prayer this week?

Game/Activity

- **Prayer Walk:** It’s time to get out (sort of) and get moving! Grab your family and put on your favorite walking shoes/bikes/scooters/whatever you want. Go for a walk around your neighborhood or one close by. While you’re walking, stop and pray over a few houses. Pray for those families and ask God to bless them during this time, to keep them safe, and to give them everything they need. Invite your kids to pray too! We want them to know and learn that there is power in prayer! You can use the prayer listed below, or you can say your own.
- Dear God, thank you for today and for always being with us. I pray over this house and this family and ask that you would be with them always, keep them safe, and bless them during this time. God please give them your joy and peace and help them know and feel your love. Amen.

Our bible tells us that when 2 or more believers are together, God hears us! It’s so comforting to know that God listens to us when we talk to him. Remind your kids of this and that prayer is powerful! Our prayers may feel small or weird, but God LOVES to hear our prayers.

Memory Verse

Read the memory verse (found at the top of the paper) together. Scripture memorization is one of the greatest tools that God gives us. When we memorize God’s word, we can apply it to our life every single day.

- God has given YOU a gift! He’s given all of us gifts! God wants us to use the gifts he’s given us to serve others around us. Take some time and find what you’re good at and how you can use it to honor God and others.

Prayer

Before you pray with your kids, take the time to ask them for any prayer requests.

Dear God, thank you for watching over us. God, help us use prayer to bless the people around us. We ask that people who don’t know you would come to know, love, and serve you. Amen.
