

## Triumphant Faith Clings to God

### Introduction:

Psalm 73 shows the temptation a child of God faces when the pure in heart suffer and the wicked prosper. In two movements, the psalm leads us from perplexity to praise, so that you, like the psalmist, would cling to God with triumphant faith.
