

Jesus is Rejected!

Introduction:

Mark's Gospel tells of the Apostle Peter's account of the life of Jesus. As Mark closes the gospel, he makes it clear that Jesus is rejected just as he had predicted he would be in 8:31, 9:31, & 10:33-34, and that Jesus's suffering was a fulfillment of the Suffering Servant (Isaiah 53).
