

Dare to Believe for Your Healing

Matt. 9:18-26 TPT “A Woman Healed by Her Faith in Jesus”

“While Jesus was still speaking, an influential Jewish leader [Jairus, the leader of the Jewish Synagogue, possibly a member of the Sanhedrin] approached and knelt before Him, saying, “Help me! My daughter has just died. Please come and place your hand upon her so that she will live again.” 19. So Jesus and his disciples got up and went with him.”

20. *“Suddenly, a woman came from behind Jesus & touched the tassel of His prayer shawl for healing [“or “for salvation.” The blue tassel on the corner of the prayer shawl was said to symbolize all commandments and promises of God.” See Num. 15:38-40]. She had been suffering from continual bleeding for twelve years, but had faith that Jesus could heal her. 21. For she kept saying to herself, “If I could only touch His prayer shawl I would be healed!”* **Smith Wigglesworth:** “She needed someone now who could heal without money, for she was bankrupt and helpless.”

22. *“Just then Jesus turned around and looked at her and said, “My daughter, be encouraged. Your faith has healed you (or “saved you.”). And instantly she was healed.”*

This lady was not permitted by religious law to be in public! Lev. 15:19 NKJV says, “*If a woman has a discharge of blood for many days, other than at the time of her customary impurity, or if it runs beyond her usual time of impurity, all the days of her unclean discharge shall be as the days of her customary impurity. She shall be unclean.*” **SFLB note:** “By Jesus’ time the religious community had used various Levitical laws to so isolate people that they felt estranged from God Himself. Jesus countered this, demonstrating God’s desire to draw near to the unclean and make them whole (as in Mark 1:40-41 & 5:24-34).”

Mark 5:29-34 TPT “As soon as her hand touched Him, her bleeding immediately stopped! She knew it, for she could feel her body instantly being healed of her disease!

30. “Jesus knew at once that someone had touched Him, for He felt the power that always surged around Him (or “the power that keeps going out of Him went out from Him”) had passed through Him for someone to be healed. He turned and spoke to the crowd, saying, **“Who touched my clothes?”** SFLB “Jesus desires to perfect the woman’s faith and to lead her to a “public confession of faith.” 31. “His disciples answered, “What do You mean, who touched you? Look at this huge crowd – they’re all pressing up against You.” 32. But Jesus’s eyes swept across the crowd, looking for the one who had touched Him for healing. 33. When the woman who experienced this miracle realized what had happened to her, she came before Him, trembling with fear, and threw herself down at His feet, saying, “I was the one who touched you.” And she told Him her story of what had just happened. 34. Then Jesus said to her, **“Daughter, because you dared to believe, your faith has healed you. Go with peace in your heart, and be free from your suffering!”**

TPT: “There were crowds around Jesus, the living Word. Many today crowd around the written Word. But only those who “**touch**” the Scriptures in faith receive its promises, just like the sick woman who received her healing.” “There was a glorious power that kept going out around Jesus Christ, drawing others to Him & healing those He touched, and in this case, healing a woman who touched Him in faith. This same miracle was repeated with Peter in Acts 5:15-16 TPT “In fact, when people knew Peter was going to walk by, they carried the sick out to the streets and laid them down on cots and mats, knowing the incredible power emanating from him would overshadow them and heal them. 16. Great numbers of people swarmed into

Jerusalem from the nearby villages. They brought with them the sick and those trouble by demons – and everyone was healed!"

Remember **Heb. 13:8 TPT**, “Jesus, the Anointed One, is always **the same** (Aramaic “Jesus the Messiah is the fulfillment of”) yesterday, today, and forever.” **Are you sick or troubled by demons? Trust Jesus today to heal you and make you well!** Jesus eyes are still sweeping through the “crowd” to see who has faith for healing! Let Him see your believing heart.

1 Pet. 2:24 TPT (re: Isa. 53:5) “He Himself carried our sins in His body on the cross so that we would be dead to sin, & live for righteousness. Our instant healing flowed from His wounding.” **SFLB note:** “Peter’s intent in quoting **Isa. 53:5** is to show that personal wholeness – mental, psychological, physical & spiritual – flows from this conversion.”

Isa. 53:4 is for Healing & Deliverance

Matt. 8:16-17 SFLB “When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, **17.** that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities (**TPT**: “weaknesses,”; **Aramaic**: “wounds” or “sores”) and bore our sicknesses.”

A Man Healed @ Solomon’s Porch Because of Another’s Faith

Acts 3:1-10 TPT “One afternoon Peter and John went to the temple for the three o’clock prayer. **2.** As they came to the entrance called the Beautiful Gate, they were captured by the sight of a man crippled from birth being carried and placed at the entrance to the temple. He was often brought there to beg for money from those going in to worship. **3.** When he noticed Peter and John going into the temple, he begged them for

money. **4.** Peter & John, looking straight into the eyes of the crippled man, said, "Look at us!" **5.** Expecting a gift, he readily gave them his attention. **6.** Then Peter said, "**I don't have money, but I'll give you this**— by the power of the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, stand up and walk!" **7-8.** Peter held out his right hand to the crippled man. As he pulled the man to his feet, suddenly power surged into his crippled feet and ankles. The man jumped up, stood there for a moment stunned, and then began to walk around! As he went into the temple courts with Peter and John, he leapt for joy and shouted praises to God. **9.** When all the people saw him jumping up and down and heard him glorifying God, **10.** they realized it was the crippled beggar they had passed by in front of the Beautiful Gate. Astonishment swept over the crowd, for they were amazed over what had happened to him." Then Peter preaches to the crowd!

Apostles Perform Signs, Wonders & Miracles; Church Grows

Acts 5:12-14 TPT "The apostles performed many signs, wonders and miracles among the people. **13.** And the believers were **wonderfully united** (NKJV "with one accord" - a harmony leading to action [Acts 2:1]) as they met regularly in the temple courts in that area known as Solomon's Porch. No one dare harm them, for everyone held them in high regard. **14.** Continually more and more people believed in the Lord and were added to their number – great crowds of both men and women."

Jesus Still Heals Today

Isa. 53:3-5 TPT All of chapter 53 speaks of Messiah Jesus. "He was despised and rejected by men, a man of deep sorrows who was no stranger to suffering and grief. We hid our faces from Him in disgust and considered Him a nobody, not worthy of respect. **4.** Yet He was the one who carried our sicknesses and endured the torment of our sufferings. We viewed Him as one

who was being punished for something He Himself had done, as one who was struck down by God and brought low. 5. But it was because of our rebellious deeds that He was pierce and because of our sins that He was crushed. He endured the punishment that made us completely whole, and in His wounding we found our healing.”* *TPT note: “This was fulfilled

in two ways. First, the Lamb of God carried away diseases as He walked the earth (Matt. 8:16-17). And second, He paid the sin price for all humanity on the cross with His sacred blood.”

Salvation & Healing Go Together

Mark 6:12-13 TPT “So they went out and preached publicly that everyone should repent. 13. They cast out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.”

If you need prayer for healing or something else, come forward now. Trust the Lord for every good thing that He has for you today!

Psa. 107:1-3 TPT “**God’s Constant Love** (“Let the redeemed of the Lord say so.”) “Let everyone give all their praise and thanks to the Lord. Here’s why – He’s better than anyone could ever imagine. Yes, He’s always loving and kind, and His faithful love never ends. 2-3. So, go ahead – let everyone know it! Tell the world how He broke through and delivered you from the power of darkness and has gathered us together from all over the world. He has set us free to be His very own!”
