



Week 6- “A New And Better Way”

In this series we are taking a few weeks to discover who Jesus is through Luke’s Gospel. He wrote an account of the True story of Jesus so that we could know the difference between grace and works. We hope to discover who Jesus is, and what He did for us. In this week’s message, we explore a few moments in Jesus’ life that show us a picture of things that impact our lives as well.

Read Luke 5:27-39 and Luke 6:1-11

1. Which way do you typically lean toward to find security, identity, value, and Joy: Self expression or self religion?
2. Why do you think that is your typical lean?
3. Have you felt the weakness in both self expression and self religion? If so, what does that look like?
4. Do you find yourself taking bits and pieces of Jesus and patching it into your ways?
5. Why is it important to be aware of how you are applying parts of Jesus' new way to your way?
6. What does it practically look like to surrender to the beauty of who Jesus is and what He did on the cross?

Jesus has invited us to live in the joy of knowing Him and walking with Him as our Savior King. When we accept his invitation we can find true rest in the

sabbath, find healing in His hands, and joy in the presence of the Bridegroom who said He would never leave us nor forsake us.
