



Week 5- “Psalm 19-The Stars Are Speaking”

In this series we will go on a journey experiencing the Psalms. The Psalms offers not just a practical, theological journey but also an experiential journey through poems and songs. The Psalms invite us to experience humanity in an honest and real way. In this week’s message, we go on a journey through Psalm 19 that takes us across the universe and deep into our own heart.

1. What stood out to you from the message?

Read Psalm 19

2. This Psalm reveals that God didn’t just want His glory to be seen, He wants to be known. What does this say about who he is?

3. Have you seen God and allowed Him to reveal himself to you?

- If so, how has knowing Him changed you?
- If not, what do you think is keeping you from seeing Him and are you willing to ask yourself why?

4. What do you practically think it means to see the cross in light of God’s Glory and the depths of your own insignificance and sin?

5. Why do you think a journey to see and know God takes a humble and grateful heart?

Read Psalm 8:3-4

6. What does the cross say about the magnitude of God’s love for you?

7. Are you willing to go on a journey to deeply know God and know the depths of your own heart? Why or why not?

8. How can this group help you discover more of who God is so that you can trust Him to go deeper into your heart?
