



Week 4- “Good News and Bad News”

In this series we are taking a few weeks to discover who Jesus is through Luke’s Gospel. He wrote an account of the True story of Jesus so that we could know the difference between grace and works. We hope to discover who Jesus is, and what He did for us. In this week’s message, we discover what Jesus says about why he came, and the way people responded to what He said.

Read Luke 4:14-30

1. What does it practically look like to experience the beauty of the Good News?
2. Why is it also important to own the reality of your brokenness and need?
3. Where might you be using Jesus to validate your agenda instead of allowing Him to transform it?
4. Why do you think it is important to evaluate where you are using Jesus to validate your agenda?
5. How does looking at the cross help you understand Jesus and yourself?
6. What does it say about God’s love for you that the cross is the solution to your brokenness and need?
7. What step can you practically take to remember the Gospel everyday and how can this group encourage you?

When we see the cross for what it is we will Own the Reality of the Bad News,

experience the beauty of the Good News, and surrender to the freedom of His kingdom, rather than our own.
