



Week 1- “Real Faith In Real Life”

Whenever Jesus talked about living out the Christian faith, he often called it a Kingdom. He constantly taught that the kingdoms the world wants to build don't work, and invites people to find the identity, protection, pardon, and blessing in God's Kingdom. In the series, we will look at the life of David and discover how He was able to live out his faith in the midst of very real circumstances and brokenness and ask the question: “How do we live this Kingdom idea in our real lives?”

1. What are some things that you wrestle with in your daily life?
2. What do you think it practically looks like to live in God's Kingdom?
3. Have you been able to experience protection, pardon, and blessing in the midst of real life and real problems? If so, what does this look like? If not, what would it mean to you if you could?

Read Psalm 143

In this series we will see how David discovered that God's Kingdom didn't fall apart based on his circumstances, fears, and failures.

4. Is this a truth you've discovered in your story? Can you share more about that?
5. What do you hope to learn from David's life that can help you trust God more?

Through the life of David our hope is to discover, develop, and deepen our understanding of the steadfast love of God and His Sovereign Lordship. Our hope

is that we can experience God's provision, pardon, and protection in the midst of our struggles, fears, failures, decisions, relationships, and all the complexities we face in our real everyday lives.
