



## **Week 7- “Jesus: Peace In A Chaotic World”**

**In this series we are taking a few weeks to discover who Jesus is through Luke’s Gospel. He wrote an account of the True story of Jesus so that we could know the difference between grace and works. We hope to discover who Jesus is, and what He did for us. In this week’s message, we explore a difficult moment that gives us a picture of what it is often like for us as we navigate life in this broken world. This story gives us a beautiful picture of the redemption Jesus brings to our lives and world.**

### **Read Luke 5:27-39**

1. What stood out to you from the message?
2. How does this story paint a picture of your experience in this broken world?
3. How does this story illuminate your need for Jesus?
4. How can remembering the beauty of the Gospel bring you security as you walk through this broken world?

### **Read Galatians 5:22**

5. Jesus invites you to lean into him when you feel the chaos of this world. What does this say about His love for you?
6. What does it practically look like to lean into Jesus as you navigate life?

7. How is leaning into the fruits of the spirit different from trying to produce them yourself?

8. How can this group encourage you to lean into Jesus for every circumstance you face and discover the real hope and peace he offers?

**When we feel the brokenness of this world, instead of standing on a broken foundation Jesus invites us to lean into Him. When we feel overwhelmed we can lean into Christ's wholeness, love, peace, joy, kindness, and experience His presence in our lives. When we accept his invitation to lean into Him we partner with Him in redeeming the world around us.**
