



Week 9- “The Debt and The Glory”

In this series we are taking a few weeks to discover who Jesus is through Luke’s Gospel. He wrote an account of the True story of Jesus so that we could know the difference between grace and works. We hope to discover who Jesus is, and what He did for us. In this week’s message, we explore an interaction that Jesus had with two people and discover that this interaction highlights a problem we all face. In this we see that Jesus offers a real way through this problem that can change everything.

Read Luke 7:36-50

1. What do you tend to look to in order to be filled?
2. The above question is asked often in our message series, why is it important to continue to evaluate this and ask yourself this question?
3. Do you feel fully known and fully loved, or do you find that you hide yourself from God and others?

Read Colossians 2:13-14

4. What does it say about your value that Jesus paid the price for your debt and has forgiven you?
5. What happens in your heart and life when you realize that Jesus has ultimately paid your debt, and you are forgiven?

6. Which statement resonates the most with you: I find my glory and worth in who Christ is and what He has done. Or I search for my value in other things.

7. What practical step can you take this week to evaluate if you have truly recognized your own debt, if you feel forgiven, and if you are living from a place of receiving Christ's glory?

8. What practical ways can you invite the Holy Spirit in to help you evaluate where your value is coming from?

When we can trust and live from a place of accepting that our debt is paid we can live from a place of fullness instead of scarcity. When we trust that what Christ has done is enough to forgive us then we can truly stand on a foundation of glory and worth instead of striving to prove our worth to ourselves and others. Christ's payment of our debt changes everything in our lives and we can rest in Who He is and what He has done for us.
