



Week 5- “The Stewardship Of Generosity”

Over the last few weeks we have been in a series called “Discovering Jesus” where we are working our way through an account of Jesus’ life according to the physician and historian Luke. As we get into the later chapters we begin to see the theme of Generosity emerge in Jesus’ teachings. In this week’s message, we explore a parable Jesus told that helps us understand some specific points he wanted to get across about money and how we use it.

Read Luke 16:1-12

1. What stood out to you from the message?
2. Do you see yourself as a manager or owner?
3. What does it practically look like to explore if generosity is growing in your heart?
4. Why is it important to evaluate if you are looking to money as a means to save you or give you value?
5. How can you become curious about what is in your heart without shaming yourself?
6. What does it say about Jesus that he challenges this without shaming people?

Read 2 Corinthians 8:9

7. How have you experienced the riches of God’s grace?
8. How does his generous grace toward you challenge you to live generously?

9. What steps can you take to invest in His Kingdom, not from a place of obligation, but from an overflow of his generosity toward you?

When we deeply know the riches of God's grace we can't help but generously want to give from the overflow of our hearts. When we trust that everything belongs to Him we also trust that He will meet our needs instead of looking to money as means to save us and give us value. Will you take a step to evaluate what is growing in your heart and surrender to the one that generously gave His life for you?
