





Jesus loved Martha and Mary and their brother Lazarus.

Jesus also tells them, that he was glad that he was not there, so that they may believe.


Thomas says let us go, that we may die with him. (not sure if this means Lazarus, or because they were wanting to stone Jesus).


When he arrived Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb four days.








Bethany was near Jerusalem, two miles. Many Jews had come to console Mary and Martha



































When he said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out."
