Starlet Knight is from Richmond and has served as a pianist in LOTS of churches in Virginia, Tennessee, and Ohio. Along the way, she's had careers in academics and industrial training. Now, she mostly provides musical direction and accompaniment/conducting for professional theater companies.

Anthony Dowd is a native Richmonder. He's been a professional jazz pianist since he was 18 when, right out of high school, he joined the Kings of Swing. He's composed more than 80 songs and releases those electronically. His career has taken him on cruise ships and to corporate gigs and to SO many fabulous sites to play a LOT of wedding receptions.

Reverend Doctor Steve Allsbrook and his wife Kathy reside in Midlothian, Virginia. They have two grown children and six grandchildren. Steve grew up in Scotland Neck, North Carolina, where his parents took him to First Baptist Church. There he professed faith in Christ during Vacation Bible School in June 1963. Kathy grew up in Mocksville, North Carolina. She made her profession of faith in Christ at First Baptist Church there. He attended North Carolina State University. She went to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. They met during a Baptist Student Union retreat. After they received their degrees in 1974, Steve and Kathy moved to Wake Forest, North Carolina. There Steve earned the Master of Divinity degree from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1977. Steve received his Doctor of Ministry degree in Missions Administration from Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary in May 1998. First Baptist Church of Scotland Neck licensed Steve to preach in 1976 and ordained Steve as a minister in 1977. Following his seminary graduation, Steve served as pastor of Tabernacle Baptist Church near South Hill, Virginia. In 1983 they moved to Farmville, Virginia where he served as pastor of Heritage Baptist Church. Steve’s ministry role changed in 1987 when he accepted the call to serve Virginia Baptists as director of associational development and church extension. From January 1, 1997 until he retired on June 30, 2017 Steve served as executive director of missions for Dover Baptist Association, a fellowship of more than 60 congregations in Virginia’s capital region. Steve and Kathy are members of Huguenot Road Baptist Church in North Chesterfield VA.
