

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FROM FEBRUARY 17/18 SERMON

- 1. After completing the Temple, the Israelites celebrated with great joy. Read <u>Ezra 6:16</u>, <u>22</u>. What causes you to celebrate the great goodness of God?
- 2. Between Ezra 6 and 7, there is a gap of 57 years. Read the following passages in Malachi to determine the spiritual state of the Israelites. Malachi 1:6-14; 2:7, 13-16; 3:5, 7-10.
- 3. King Artaxerxes generously gave Ezra many provisions. Read <u>Ezra 7:11-26</u>. What provisions did Artaxerxes provide? What was his motive?
- 4. Read Ezra 7:27-28. How did Ezra respond to Artaxerxes' generosity?
- 5. Read <u>Ezra 7:6 and 7:9</u>. What does the writer mean by "the hand of the Lord his God was on him?" How is God's hand on us today?
- 6. The trip from Babylon was a four-month dangerous journey. Why did Ezra not ask for a military escort? Read Ezra 8:21-23.
- 7. Read Ezra 7:10. What does it mean to set your heart on something?
- 8. Read <u>Psalm 19:7-11</u> and <u>2 Timothy 3:16-17</u>. Why is the study of God's Word critical for spiritual growth?
- 9. Read <u>James 1:22-24</u>. This passage discusses the critical nature of applying God's Word to our lives.
- 10. Discuss ways in which every believer can teach God's Word.
