3. There are seven I AM statements recorded in the book of John. This week, we considered John 8:12 where Jesus said, *“I am the light of the world.”* **Read Exodus 3:13-15.** Why did we say it was so significant that Jesus began each statement with *I am?*

4. 1 John 1:7 says, *“But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another.”* Discuss how this verse speaks to the importance of believers being connected to one another. How has God impacted your life through fellowship with other believers in small groups?

5. **Read Matthew 5:14-16.** Throughout this series, we will be challenging you to take “Easter Action.” What are some ways you can “let your light shine before others” this week?

Exodus 3:13-15

¹³ Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" ¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I am who I am."^[a] And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I am has sent me to you.'" ¹⁵ God also said to Moses, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'The Lord,^[b] the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations.

A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that^[a] they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.
