1. Read Hebrews 10:19-25. We said this weekend:

*Let us with confidence and wholehearted devotion (v.19-22): **Keep our present hope anchored in Jesus (v.23).***

How can we as a church practically keep our daily hope in the Lord and not start to put our hope in the things of this world (money, fame, politics, etc.)?

2. We said this weekend...

*Let us with confidence and wholehearted devotion: **Challenge one another (v.24).***

Why is it healthy for us to challenge one another in our faith walk? Share a time when someone challenged you.

3. We said this weekend:

*Let us with confidence and wholehearted devotion: **Prioritize worshipping together (v.25).***

What's the danger in "solo Christianity" ...meaning a believer not being connected to a local church or not prioritizing corporate worship?

4. We said this weekend:

*Let us with confidence and wholehearted devotion: **Encourage one another (v.25)***

We shared this weekend some practical ways to encourage one another are through prayer, scripture, and example (our model of obedience). What are other ways we can encourage each other? Share an experience where another believer encouraged you and it greatly impacted your faith walk.



5. We said this weekend:

*Let us with confidence and wholehearted devotion: **Live with urgency (v.25).***

Why is it important for believers to live with a sense of urgency as if Jesus is returning tomorrow? What would change in your life if you lived with more spiritual urgency?

Hebrews 10:19-25

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers,^[a] since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
