- 1. Read <u>Haggai 1:5, 7, 8, 12-14</u>. How should we respond when we are stuck on ourselves?
- 2. Read <u>Haggai 2:9</u>. What do we need to remember when we are stuck in the past?
- 3. Read Haggai 2:12-14. What should we do when we are stuck in sin?
- 4. What does repentance mean? How does repentance for the unbeliever differ from repentance for the believer?
- 5. Read <u>1 John 1:6-9</u>. What does God promise when we confess our sins?
- 6. Read Zechariah 3:1-4. Discuss the meaning of this passage.
- 7. In the Old Testament, obedience was often rewarded by physical blessings. Read Ephesians 1:3-14. What are the spiritual blessings for the believer?
- 8. Read Ezra 5:1-5. What caused Zerubbabel to fear?
- 9. Read <u>Haggai 2:20-23</u>. What is the significance of God saying that Zerubbabel would be "like a signet ring"?
- 10. Review and discuss the ten promises found in the book of Haggai. What comfort do these promises give you today?

## THE PROMISES OF HAGGAI

- "Thus says the Lord of hosts" (1:5, 7, 9, 14; 2:4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 23).
- "I am with you" (1:13)
- "Be strong...for I am with you" (2:4)
- "My Spirit remains in your midst" (2:5)

- "Fear not" (2:5)
- "The silver in mine and the gold is mine" (2:8
- "I will give peace" (2:9)
- "...From this day on I will bless you" (2:19)
- "I am about to shake the heavens and earth..." (2:21)
- "...I have chosen you...." (2:23)
