The longings which arise in us when we first fall in love, or first think of some foreign country, or first take up some subject that excites us, are longings which no marriage, no travel, not learning, can really satisfy. I am not speaking of what would be ordinarily called unsuccessful marriages, or holidays, or leaned careers. I am speaking about the best possible ones.
