2. **Review: Read Acts 2:42.** What are the four things new believers devoted themselves? Why is fellowship (*koinonia*) so important in Christian community?
3. **Read Genesis 2:18, Ecclesiastes 4:9-12, and Proverbs 27:17.** Why is community so important as a Christian? Why is it dangerous to not be connected with other believers?
4. **Read Acts 2:43-44 and Psalm 133.** Discuss the power of unity in a world that is confused and divided.
5. Share a time when others helped you through a difficult time. Discuss why you believe community is so important for our church.

### Acts 2:42

The Fellowship of the Believers

*<sup>42</sup> And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.*

### Acts 2:44-45

*<sup>44</sup> All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.*

### Genesis 2:18

*<sup>18</sup> Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for<sup>[a]</sup> him."*

### Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

*<sup>9</sup> Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. <sup>10</sup> For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up! <sup>11</sup> Again, if two lie together, they keep warm, but how can one keep warm alone? <sup>12</sup> And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken.*
