# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FROM January 2 SERMON**

**ICEBREAKER:** What are your thoughts on New Year's Resolutions? If you do them, would you be willing to share one?

- 1. Read Philippians 3:7-11. Why is Paul willing to "count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord"?
- Read Philippians 3:12-14. How can one forget what lies behind and strain forward to
  what lies ahead? Discuss what Paul means when he says he is pressing "on toward the
  goal."
- 3. Paul uses the phrase "in Christ" eighty-six times in his letters to describe the believer's position. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. From this passage (and others), what does it mean to be "in Christ?"
- 4. Read Philippians 2:1. Discuss the four spiritual benefits of being in Christ. Which spiritual benefit do you most resonate with and why?

#### Philippians 3:7-11 ESV

<sup>7</sup> But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. <sup>8</sup> Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ <sup>9</sup> and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith— <sup>10</sup> that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, <sup>11</sup> that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
